Leaving people out, whispering about others,

Using social media, sending messages or pictures



# Bullying can be a group behaviour with different roles played by different people

#### Ringleader

Leads bullying but may not do anything

#### Defender

Stands up for someone being bullied

#### Outsider

Ignores that anything is happening



#### Target

The person who may be being bullied

#### **Assistant**

Involved in the bullying

Reinforcer

Encourages the ringleader
