Exploring the symbolism of light

Key vocabulary

Jesus	The Son of God
Light	A type of energy that makes it possible for us to see what is around us
Candles	A stick of wax containing a wick, burned to give light and used in different ceremonies
Christingle	Christingle means Christ's light, churches hold services around Christmas time to celebrate the light of Christ using Christingles
Light of the world	A name used to describe Jesus
Saviour	Someone who is sent to save (Jesus was our saviour as he died for our sins)
Incarnation	A person e.g. Jesus who is God in the flesh
Hanukkah	A Jewish festival that runs for 8 days in December, a special candle is lit each night
Hannukiah	Is another name for a Menorah, a candle holder for 9 candles - 1 for each night of Hanukkah
Jerusalem	City where Jesus was taken as a child and later was crucified on Good Friday
Temple	A place of worship
