The Transfiguration Matthew, Mark and Luke		Jesus changed his appearance to show he was the Son of God, when praying his face shone, his clothes dazzling white, then a voice said "This is my beloved Son, with whom I am please; listen to him" Matthew 17:5
Jesus drives out impure spirits Luke 4:31-37		Jesus met a man who was possessed by a demon, Jesus sternly said "Come out of him!" The demon came out and the man was ok, people were amazed.
