



INTERNET SAFETY

1. Never give out personal information such as phone numbers, addresses, passwords or share photos.
2. Talk to your parents, carers or teachers if you feel uncomfortable with what you see on the internet.
3. Be polite and respectful of others on-line. Never send a message you would not say face-to-face.
4. Never meet up with someone you meet on-line.
5. When chatting on-line, do not use your real name so that you don't reveal anything about you.
