



conjunction	used to join sentences together	<i>and, but, or, because, so</i>
synonym	different words that have the same meaning	<i>big and large happy and joyful</i>
verb	an action, doing or being word	<i>swoop, soar</i>
compound words	two or more words are joined to make a new word	<i>sun + flower = sunflower</i>
noun	name of people, places and things	<i>Mia, lake, plane</i>
adjectives	used to describe a noun	<i>beautiful plane</i>
plurals	when there is more than one (adding 's' or 'es')	<i>boy - boys, plane - planes</i>
similes	a comparison using 'as' or 'like'	<i>as quiet as a mouse</i>
sentence starters	to help order your story	<i>first, then, next, after,</i>
