river	<i>a flowing, moving stream of water that feeds an ocean, lake, pond or another river</i>
settlement	<i>a place where people have come together to live</i>
map	<i>a drawing of all or part of Earth's surface to show where things are</i>
tourism	<i>the act of travelling somewhere for enjoyment</i>
landmark	<i>an object or a feature that has importance or makes a place easily recognisable</i>

Study of things that have been built by humans, such as roads and bridges

Physical geography

Study of the Earth's surface formed by nature

weather	beach	coastline	forest
