



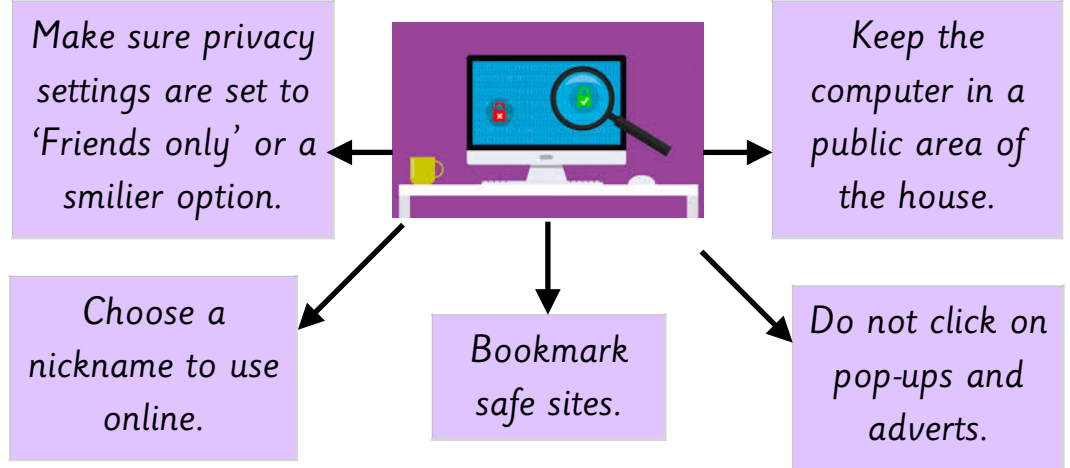

Keyword	A word of great importance.
Safe	Not at risk of harm or danger.
Online	Connected to computer network.
Websites	A location on the internet. A website contains a home page and other pages that are linked to the home page.
Internet	The world's largest computer network, which is made of millions of computers that are linked together
Source	Belonging to a particular person.
Search	To look through very carefully in order to find something.
Information	Knowledge or facts that come from an exact place.
Cyberbullying	Bullying that is done by posting hurtful electronic messages on the internet.
Email	A written message sent from one computer to another.
Communicate	Share information, news, or ideas.

Sending abusive, or threatening messages to someone.	When someone takes a picture or video of themselves and sends it to someone else.	Being abusive towards someone / harassing them on an online	Sending abusive emails is a type of bullying.	Sometimes people might get nasty messages in a chat room
Sharing the texts with other people who might join in the bullying.	Sometimes people who are trying to bully someone may send the images to other people.	Multi-player gaming site is also a kind of online bullying.	Sometimes those emails might be shared with other people who could join in the bullying	Sending those messages using someone else's account without their permission is also online bullying
