Key Vocabulary

Safe	Protected from danger or risk; not likely to be harmed or lost.
Unsafe	Not safe; dangerous.
Dangerous	Able or likely to cause harm or injury.
Liquid	A substance that flows freely but is of constant volume, like that of water or oil.
Symbol	A thing that represents or stands for something else
Hazard	A danger or risk.
Cigarettes	A thin cylinder of finely cut tobacco rolled in paper for smoking.
Risky	Full of the possibility of danger, failure, or loss.
Lighter	A device that produces a small flame, especially one used to light cigarettes.

Harmful Substances		Symbol
Explosive	A substance which can be made to explode, especially any of those used in bombs or shells.	
Irritant	A substance that causes slight inflammation or other discomfort to the body.	
Flammable	Easily set on fire.	
Toxic	Relating to or caused by poison.	
Corrosive	Tending to cause corrosion.
