





Key vocabulary

Conditions	Each habitat has different conditions such as the amount of light, or the temperature
environment	The area in which something exists or lives.
habitat	A place that an animal or plant lives. It provides the animal or plant with food, water and shelter.
inhabitant	A person or animal that lives in a place.
microhabitat	A very small, specific habitat for animals and plants.
organism	A living thing.

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
