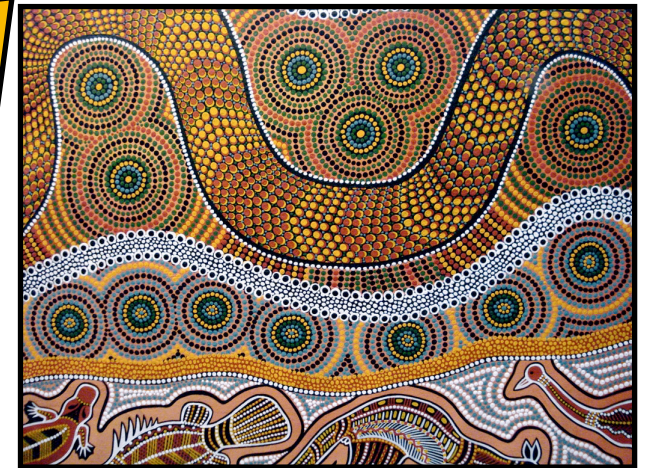


Vocabulary

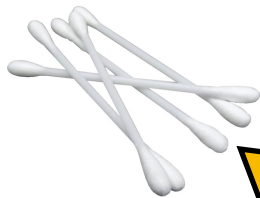
aboriginal	earliest, native, first

modify	to change or alter to improve
inlay	a decorative technique used to make a pattern by pressing
forming	to make into a specific shape
pinching	squeeze, nip, tweak



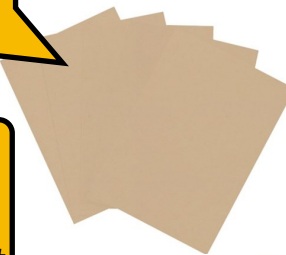
Aboriginal art is based on ancient 'dreamtime' stories and is recognisable for its use of lines, dots and earthy tones.
