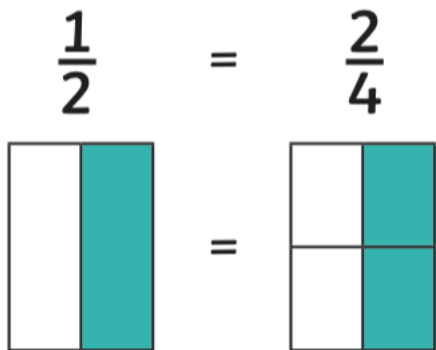

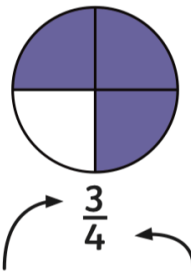
Key vocabulary

Unit Fraction	A fraction where the top number (the "numerator") is 1
Numerator	The numerator is the top number of a fraction.
Denominator	The denominator is the bottom number of a fraction.
Whole	All of something. Complete.
Equal	Exactly the same amount or value
Equivalent Fraction	Fractions with the same value.

Numerator and Denominator



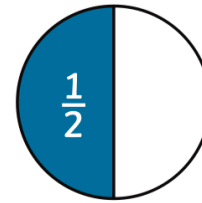
Numerator

Denominator
How many equal parts are in the whole?

Recognising Unit Fractions

Half

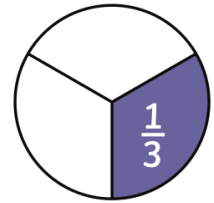
A whole split into two equal parts.



$$\frac{1}{2} \text{ of } 8 = 4$$

Third

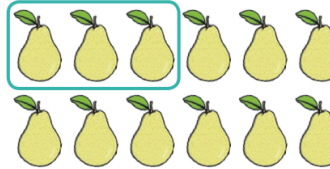
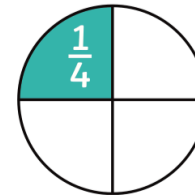
A whole split into three equal parts.



$$\frac{1}{3} \text{ of } 6 = 2$$

Quarter

A whole split into four equal parts.



$$\frac{1}{4} \text{ of } 12 = 3$$

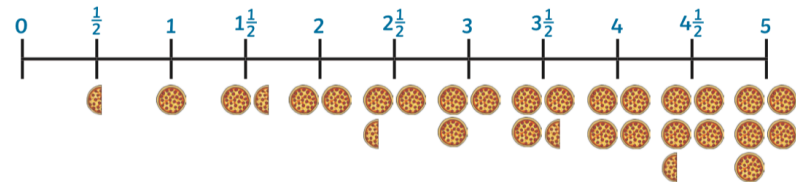


$\frac{3}{4}$

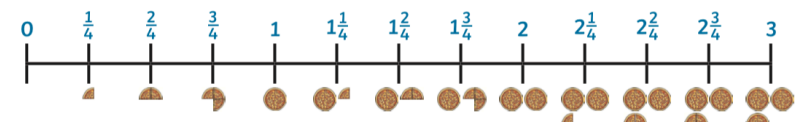


Counting in Fractions
