Key vocabulary

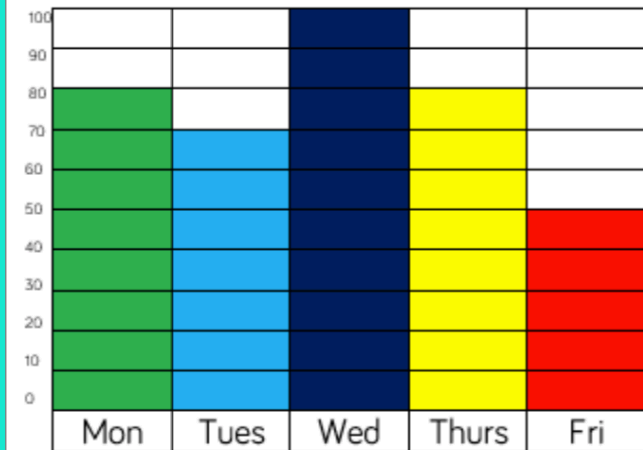
Data	A collection of facts, such as numbers, words or measurements.
Graph	A diagram of values, usually shown as lines or bars.
Chart	A sheet of information in the form of a table, graph or diagram.
Pictogram	A pictogram uses pictures or symbols to show the value of data.
Bar graph	A graph showing values with rectangular bars. The bars can be vertical or horizontal.
Tally	A way of keeping count by drawing marks. The fifth mark goes across the other four.

Question types

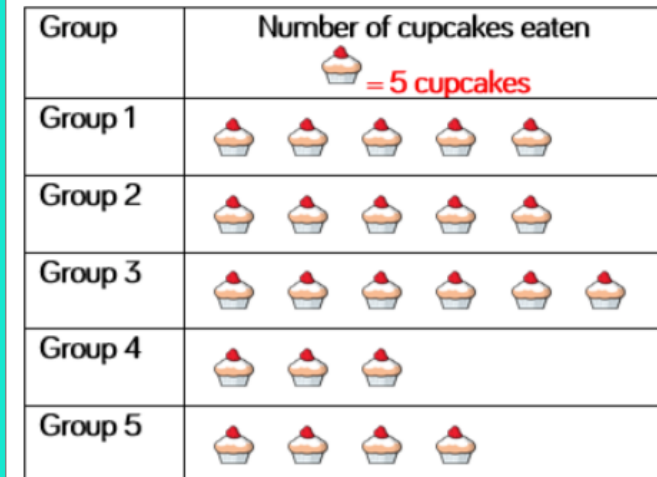
More than	How many more hours is the shop open on a Monday then a Wednesday?
Less than	Group 3 eat 30 cakes, how many fewer cakes did Group 4 eat?
Difference between	What was the difference between people who liked cricket and rugby?
Most popular	Which sport was the most popular?
Least popular	Which was least popular? Tennis or cricket?
