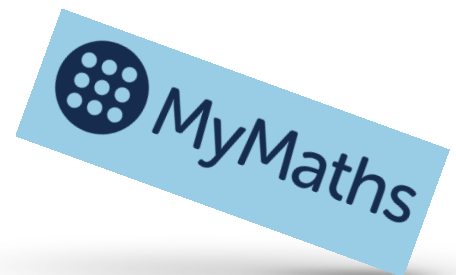
Seesaw is a digital learning journal which allows pupils to create, share and interact with their teachers. We use this to assign some homework (e.g. Values at the start of term) and also use this within certain lessons where tasks are completed in a variety of different ways, uploading images, videos or voice notes. It can also be used to share examples of our Inspirations.



Times Tables Rock Stars is a maths programme that takes all the worry out of learning times tables and has a proven track record of boosting children's fluency and recall in multiplication and division.

Suitable for all learners aged 6 years+, their question-based games automatically adapt to each child's unique learning needs, helping them to recall their times tables in record speed.

At Bishop Martin, we follow the Spelling Shed spelling scheme from Years 2-6. Spelling Shed is also available to access from home, with a variety of fun and engaging spelling games. After logging in, your child will have an assignment set from their teacher each week. Alternatively, choose the 'stage' that matches each year group (e.g. Stage 3 = Year 3 etc.) to practise a wide-range of sounds and spelling rules.
