


Using knowledge organisers (KOs) at home - Parent's guide

Vocabulary check Cover the definitions and ask your child to explain them.

Read the definitions and ask your child to guess the word.

You can cover over some of the key events and ask you child to fill in the blanks or explain events.



Use the KO to ask children more challenging questions. For example, here they could make their own numbers using Roman numerals.

Can you make a list of countries that the Romans ruled or invaded?

You could ask further questions about the content by asking how or why.

Top tips

- Give children the chance to read/revise the KO regularly
- Recap key learning through discussion before quizzing
- Allow children to share their knowledge with you through writing down everything they have remembered
- See if children can re-create their KO on a blank page

If there is a timeline get children to write the dates in order.
